Introduction

Christians for Education is a Christian charity based in north Wales whose aim is to encourage churches to develop links with their local schools and colleges. The emphasis is on giving churches a toolkit of ideas and help to assist them in supporting schools and colleges in their locality, whilst also being an encouragement to young people exploring the Christian faith. The work is predominantly in the Prestatyn to Conwy area.

C4E is a local mission partner of Scripture Union and works in accordance with their statement of faith, policies and practices.

The charity is looking to appoint someone for the equivalent of 12 hours a week to coordinate the work of C4E. The salary is in line with the voluntary living wage, currently £12 an hour, which is financed by grants and gifts.

It is a genuine occupational requirement for this position that the employee is a practising Christian (Equality Act 2010, schedule 9).

Job description

The successful candidate will be responsible for:

- Contacting and working with local churches to encourage them to support their local schools and colleges.
- Giving practical help in schools and colleges to facilitate and demonstrate school/church partnership activities.
- Posting on relevant social media platforms and keeping the C4E website updated.
- Fostering links with other Christian organisations that work with schools and colleges.
- Various administrative tasks including:
maintaining a list of church/school/college contacts in line with GDPR; writing a monthly progress report to discuss with their line manager; attending C4E half termly trustees' meetings; writing supporters letters and updating the C4E schools/colleges ideas toolkit.
- Working on other projects as agreed by the trustees.
