This year marks six since years since Rooted launched. In that time we have seen hundreds of schools and communities start Rooted hubs using the tools created to support young people and children to explore the roots of who they are. The leaders' guide, personal journals and Rooted hub questions cards have supported both leaders and young people in creating space to discover more of what Jesus says. The Grow journal has been a fab tool to support young people in their walk with God. In 2020 we saw the launch of Rooted junior adapting the resources for 8- to 11-year-olds, we have seen a great interest from primary schools with Rooted junior, creating space for children to explore more about faith and wellbeing. This year we will be running our fourth rooted retreat where rooted hubs gather together for a weekend in the north west. We will also be launching new online spaces alongside our hybrid work within SU. 2024 is going to be an exciting year for the development of Rooted and I look forward to sharing more over the next few months.
