I can't wait to work alongside a new Faith Guide, using Revealing Jesus as the blueprint and dreaming about how we can reach the children, young people and families in Dartmouth.

Surf Break // 12th-14th July

I am thrilled to be part of running a new surf holiday in July aimed at Faith Guides bringing the groups of young people they are serving in their local context.

We recognise the importance of residentials in the faith journey of children and young people and many of you will know SU from years and years of running holidays and missions – my introduction to SU was through a week-long residential in South Wales over 25 years ago.

Over the last year we have been creating Faith Guide holidays that specifically complement the Revealing Jesus framework and are aimed at those leaders doing year-round relational mission – tailoring holidays that serve their needs.

I can think of nothing better to do than spend time with young people on the coast, learning to surf; Surf Break will run from 12–14 July and take place at Menadue Farm, Tintagel for 13- to 18-year-olds. If you want to know more please get in touch.
