Key Responsibilities:

- **Programme Delivery:** Deliver engaging school-based sessions, including, but not limited to RE lessons, assemblies, and events like *Christmas Unwrapped*, *Easter Cracked*, and *It's Your Move*. Develop new and innovative ideas which promote the spiritual development of Primary children in Thanet.
- **Partner Engagement:** Build and maintain positive relationships with schools, churches, and partner organisations (e.g., Open the Book, Prayer Spaces, Scripture Union, and Starfish Mentoring). Promotion of ACTS in churches, schools and other settings.
- **Resource Development:** Create necessary resources, including lesson plans, craft activities, and other appropriate aids for use in school sessions that help develop primary-aged children's understanding of the Christian faith and promote spiritual development.

- **Volunteer Support:** Provide support, training, and guidance to volunteers to deliver and/or support school-based sessions, working in close collaboration with the ACTS Volunteer Co-ordinator to ensure volunteers are well-placed, vetted, and supported.
- **Strategic Planning:** Develop a yearly plan in conjunction with the Project Manager, bringing forward new, innovative ideas to reach primary children.
- **Administration:** Provide regular feedback to the Project Manager and manage general administrative tasks as required. Any other duties or responsibilities reasonably requested by the trustees or management.

- **Professional Background:** Experience in a teaching, education, or school-based role (e.g., QTS, HLTA, or significant classroom support experience).
- **Passion:** A genuine passion to see the children of Thanet grow spiritually and explore the Christian faith.
- **Teamwork:** A strong team ethic and the ability to work collaboratively in a small, part-time team to support our collective mission.
